

Focus Stacking using Lightroom and Photoshop

1. **Select All** the images in the stack in Lightroom.
2. Right mouse click, **Edit in / Open as layers in Photoshop**
3. In Photoshop **Select all the layers**
 - 3.1. Go to Edit on the top horizontal menu bar.
 - 3.2. **Auto-align layers** (use Auto projection)
 - 3.3. Then **Auto-Blend layers** (Stack images option)
4. **File Save** and the image will be imported back into Lightroom.

Focus Stacking using just Photoshop

1. **File** (top horizontal menu bar)/**Scripts/Load files into Stack**
2. Right mouse click, **Edit in / Open as layers in Photoshop.**
3. Browse to find the **images** you want to open up, **select all of them then click Open.**
4. In the Load Layers dialog box, select **Attempt to Automatically Align Source Images** then click OK.
5. Go to Edit on the top horizontal bar. Chose **Auto-Blend layers** (Stack images option). Tick Seamless Tones and Colours.
6. **File Save.**
