Focus Stacking using Lightroom and Photoshop

- 1. Select All the images in the stack in Lightroom.
- 2. Right mouse click, Edit in / Open as layers in Photoshop
- 3. In Photoshop Select all the layers
 - 3.1. Go to Edit on the top horizontal menu bar.
 - 3.2. Auto-align layers (use Auto projection)
 - 3.3. Then Auto-Blend layers (Stack images option)
- 4. File Save and the image will be imported back into Lightroom.

Focus Stacking using just Photoshop

- File (top horizontal menu bar)/Scripts/Load files into Stack
- 2. Right mouse click, Edit in / Open as layers in Photoshop.
- Browse to find the images you want to open up, select all of them then click Open.
- In the Load Layers dialog box, select Attempt to Automatically Align Source Images then click OK.
- Go to Edit on the top horizontal bar. Chose Auto-Blend layers (Stack images option). Tick Seamless Tones and Colours.
- 6. File Save.
